

Music – this term, the children will learn about tempo, rhythm and ostinato. They will learn about Djembe drums and African music.

Science – This term the children will investigate electricity. They will be able to experiment by making their own circuits, forming and testing a hypothesis, identifying conductors and insulators and identifying the function of a switch.

P.E. – This term, the children will develop their fitness in athletics and complete Outdoor Adventurous Activities throughout their residential.

English – In English, the children will continue to use a variety of stimuli to build on their understanding of different genres. They will continue to develop their understanding of punctuation and vocabulary through various genres: diaries, persuasive texts, letters and poetry.

Computing - In computing, the children will be continuing their learning about programming and sensing movement.

PSHE - Throughout this term the children will develop their knowledge and understanding of their relationships, specifically those online. Later, they will learn how their bodies change and develop. We will also discuss transitions into new year groups and high school and how to prepare for this.

Art - the children will be completing a piece of art for the Mendlesham Heritage fair (6th May). They will also be creating self-portraits using different textiles, taking inspiration from Frida Kahlo.

D&T – the children will be developing their cooking skills and construction skills. They will produce their own recipe and a structure such as a playground.

History – During this term, the children will be learning about The Trojan Horse. They will listen and learn the events of the Greek myth and will conclude, using historical evidence, whether the event was myth, fact or legend.

Maths – The children will continue to embed their knowledge of fractions. This will be the foundation on which they then build their understanding of decimals and percentages. They will continue to develop their knowledge of geometry,
