We will be working to improve our techniques in sketching. We will be exploring how artists create perspective.

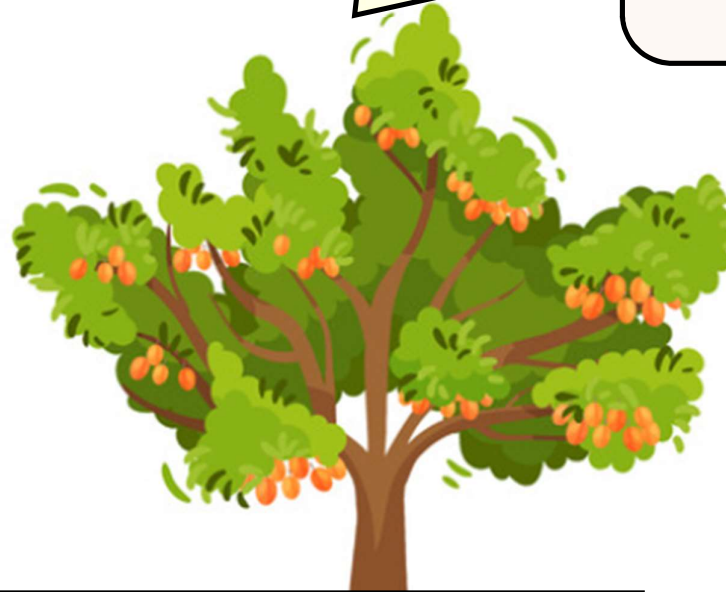
D&T

We will be putting our electrical understanding to the test by creating our own torches.

Science

States of matter: We will be learning about the different states of matter and what happens as a material moves between each state. We will also be designing our own experiments to test our ideas.

Electricity: Tying in with our D&T project, we will be exploring how to make increasingly complex electrical circuits, as well as looking at safety issues around working with electricity.



History

This half term, we will be looking at what life was like during the Tudor times in England. We will be using examples of primary and secondary sources to help us investigate ideas around who they were and their impact on life in England.

English

This term, we will continue to practise and develop our writing skills through the context of diary writing, non-chronological reports, how to write myth and legend narratives, as well as exploring Haikus and Free Verse poetry. Throughout each unit, children will develop their understanding of the key features of each type of text, they develop their vocabulary, continue to develop their use of punctuation, and practise their sentence writing.

Maths

This term, Year 4s will be beginning their journey to learning all of their multiplication facts, while the Year 5s recap theirs. We will be exploring place value with increasingly large numbers, looking at methods for each of the four main operations and recapping and developing our understanding of length, perimeter and area.
