

Maths

This term, starting with place value, we look at how this helps us to develop our understanding addition and subtraction using tens and ones. We will be using a range of equipment and pictorial examples in order to develop depth of understanding in maths.

Science

This term, we will be looking at three different units: groups and classifying living things, data collection, and states of matter. Through each unit we will be developing our understanding of how to carry out fair tests as well as designing our own simple experiments to test our ideas.

English

This term, we will continue to practise and develop our writing skills through the context of storytelling, as well as letter writing and descriptive poetry. Throughout each unit, children will work to develop their understanding of the key features and structures of each type of text, as well as developing their vocabulary and practise their use of punctuation.

ICT

We will be looking at E-Safety and researching some of the strategies that we can use to stay safe on-line. We will also be looking photo-editing.

P.E.

This term, PE will on Monday and Wednesday afternoons. We will be learning how to play hockey and boccia, which will help us to develop our hand-eye coordination and team-working strategies.

Art

In art, we will be focusing on developing our sketching skills. Taking inspiration from portrait artist, Rita Maggart, we will look at how we can improve our own skills through the medium of charcoal.

D&T

We will be putting our understanding of electronics to the test by building working torches. Children will need to bring in some recycling items for this, but I will let you know exactly what is needed closer to the time.

History
