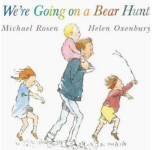
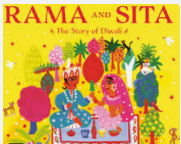
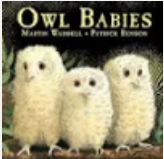
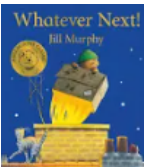
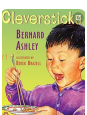
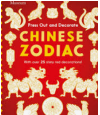
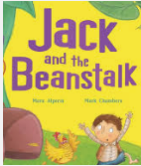
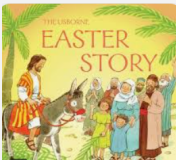
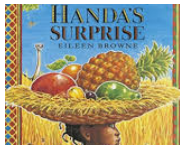


Curriculum Overview EYFS
