## Geography

**United Kingdom Study:** We will name, locate and identify the 4 countries of the U.K and discuss our experiences of visiting them. We will also make observations of seasonal weather patterns in the U.K.

### Science

**Materials:** We will identify, name and discuss the uses of everyday materials. We will conduct experiments, make observations and draw conclusions on materials and their properties.

## **English**

## Maths
