Music

Science

English



We will be exploring what Christians believe and investigating some of the key aspects of the faith, such as important festivals, symbols.

French

Children will be taught French by language specialists from the High School. They begin by building up vocabulary and gaining confidence in speaking.

Art

We will be learning about colour and how to manipulate this to create different atmospheres; this will link in with our Adventure writing, in English.

History

Maths
