

Music

This term, we will be taking on a new instrument with the music service. We will also be learning how to make the best use of our vocal skills, in readiness for the Christmas production.

Science

Animals, including humans: We will be building upon our learning from the summer term (Wellbeing Week) around the importance of a healthy diet and the impact upon the body. We will be exploring some of the different processes and the structures within the body and designing our own experiments to test our ideas on the topic.

English

Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening. We will focus on different text types this term, including poetry, adventure and mysteries stories, formal letters and scripts. Throughout these, children will build on their sentence structures and vocabulary, a range of punctuation and work towards gaining their pen licences.

ICT

We will be looking at E-Safety and some of the strategies to help stay safe on-line. We will also be looking at how to use the internet for research and how check the reliability of a source.

P.E.

This term, we will be putting our Maths and geography skills into action with orienteering. After half term, we will be learning tactics and improving our invasion game skills in tag rugby.

Art

We will be learning about colour and how to manipulate this to create different atmospheres; this will link in with our Adventure and Mystery writing, in English.

D&T

We will be putting our design and constructions skills to the test by creating our own Anglo-Saxon homes.

History

This term, we will be learning all about the Anglo-Saxons. We will researching where they came from, why they came, how the selected where to build their settlements, how they lived, as well as their beliefs and culture.

Maths

We will be taking a mastery approach to Maths, which means that the children will be able to explore the Maths concepts to a deeper level through problem solving. This term, we will be focusing up the four major operations (addition, subtraction, division and multiplication). We will also be looking at perimeter and area.

R.E.

We will be exploring what Christians believe and investigating some of the key aspects of the faith, such as important festivals, symbols and their use of language.

French

Children will be building up their vocabulary, constructing simple sentences as well as consolidating their learning from last year.

Geography

We will working on our map skills, with particular emphasis on different land use. We will also looking at the symbols used as well as having a go a draft a basic map.
