

Geography

Mendlesham: We will explore places using a compass and directional language. Then create maps using a key. We will also continue to make observations of seasonal patterns in the U.K.

P.E.

Games: We will explore throwing and catching techniques, whilst improving our agility.

Gymnastics: We will create, perform and share sequences. We will work on body tension and movements which use different levels.

Art and DT

Self portrait: Art- We will improve our painting techniques whilst exploring line, form, pattern and shape. DT- We will produce a sculpture of our faces using clay and shaping tools.

Science

Animals, including humans: We will name and compare the structure of animals and classify them as carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. We will use our observations to answer questions and research in order to produce information leaflets.

History

My life so far- We will explore changes within living memory and compare our childhoods now, to those of people growing up in the 1960s. We will explore timelines and explain events in order of time.

English

We will explore stories to do with animals and zoos and use this as the basis for our own story writing. We will then research mammals using non-fiction texts and the internet, using what we learn to write information leaflets. We will link our learning with History to read short biographies of important figures and write recalled facts ourselves.

Maths

We will explore number patterns and relationships such as doubles. We will investigate and build up mental methods of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also explore fractions of objects and shapes, position and movement, telling the time and collecting data using tallies and charts.

Computing

Creating and retrieving data- We will use the internet to research animals in Science and create documents with our findings. We will learn to type, edit, check, save and retrieve our work.

R.E.

Judaism- belonging, believing, prayer and worship: We will learn about the ways in which Jews worship and pray.

Celebrations: We will explore how and why Passover is celebrated.

Families: We will learn about what it means to belong to a family and how all families are different and special.

Healthy eating: We will explore what our bodies need to stay healthy, linking our learning to Science.
