

Music

We will be continuing our work with the recorder, which is led by the music service. The children are learning how to use their instrument and how to read music.

Science

Forces and magnets: We will be learning about the different forces and how they impact movement. We will be exploring magnetism and what types of materials are magnetic. We will be designing our own experiments to test our ideas.

Plants: We will be looking at the structure of plants, what they need to survive and comparing them to our understanding of animals from the autumn term.

English

Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening. We will focus on different text types this term, including dilemma stories, stories from other cultures and how we can use good vocabulary within poetry. To support this, a key focus will be using conjunctions to vary sentence structure, increasing our range of vocabulary and how writers use inference in writing about character. We will be reading some of our work to an audience, using good expression, pace and volume.

ICT

We will be continuing our programming work by using Scratch.

P.E.

This term, we will be creating dances and developing our tactics within invasion games.

We will also be visiting Pipers Vale to develop our gymnastics skills.

Art

We will be working to improve our techniques in sketching and taking inspiration from the work of John Brunsdon to create our own work.

D&T

We exploring the use of cams in toys and attempting to create our own moving toy.

History

This half term, we will be looking at what happened in Britain when the Vikings arrived. What did the Vikings want and how did the Anglo Saxon king, Alfred, help to stop them? We will be using examples of primary and secondary sources to help us investigate ideas around how and why they were so successful.
