

Music

We will be continuing our work with the recorder, which is led by the music service. The children are learning how to use their instrument and how to read music.

P.E.

This term, we will be creating dances and developing our tactics within invasion games.

We will also be visiting Pipers Vale to develop our gymnastics skills.

Art

We will be working to improve our techniques in sketching and taking inspiration from the work of John Brunsdon to create our own work.

D&T

We exploring the use of cams in toys and attempting to create our own moving toy.

Science

Forces and magnets: We will be learning about the different forces and how they impact movement. We will be exploring magnetism and what types of materials are magnetic. We will be designing our own experiments to test our ideas.

Plants: We will be looking at the structure of plants, what they need to survive and comparing them to our understanding of animals from the autumn term.

History

This half term, we will be looking at what happened in Great Britain when the Vikings arrived. We will be using examples of primary and secondary sources to help us investigate ideas around who they were and their impact on the UK.

English

Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening. We will focus on different text types this term, including issue and dilemmas, stories from other cultures and word play within poetry. Throughout these, children will build on their sentence structures and vocabulary, a range of punctuation and continue to work towards gaining their pen licences.

Maths

This term, we will be moving on our understanding of multiplication and division to explore fractions and decimals. We will be practising to tell the time and using it to solve various problems. We will also be continuing to practise our formal methods for the four main operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division).

R.E.

We will be developing our understanding of Judaism and exploring how their beliefs compare to other religions that we are familiar with.

French

Children will continue their work with to build up their vocabulary as well as constructing simple sentences.

Geography

We will be developing our understanding of land use from last term to explore megacities. We will be investigating why people choose to live in such environments and their impact on the local area.

ICT

We will be continuing our programming work by using Scratch.
