

- Angel Falls is three times as tall as Paris landmark, the Eiffel Tower.

The waterfall has been known as the Angel Falls since the mid-20th century. They were named after Jimmie Angel, a US aviator, who was the first person to fly over the falls.

Angel Falls is a waterfall in Venezuela.

- It is the world's highest uninterrupted waterfall, with a height of 979m and a plunge of 507m.
- The waterfall drops over the edge of the Auyán-tepui mountain in the Canaima National Park.

5 SKYSCRAPERS

BURJ KHALIFA
BURJ KHALIFA is the tallest building in the world at 828m tall and is in *UNITED ARAB EMIRATES*. There are 2909 stairs to level 160 to get even higher they have to use ladders. It would take 569 of me to get to the top.

EMPIRE STATE BUILDING
EMPIRE STATE BUILDING is 381m tall and is positioned in also the *UNITED STATES*. It would take 262 of me to reach the top.

ONE WORLD TRADE CENTER
ONE WORLD TRADE CENTER is tall but not tall enough to be the tallest at 541m tall and is in the *UNITED STATES*. It would take 373 of me to reach the top.

CITIC PLAZA
CITIC PLAZA is only 297m tall and it is in the country *CHINA*. It is the 35th tallest skyscraper in the world. It would take 204 of me to reach the top.

PING AN FINANCE CENTER
PING AN FINANCE CENTER is 555m tall and is positioned in *CHINA*. It would take 382 of me to get to the top.
