Art will follow the focus on ourselves as children learn to draw from observation to create self-portraits.



D.T

Science

Earth and Space: We will be learning about the Solar System, and focussing in particular on the names of the planets and the position of the Earth and the moon.

Light and shadows: We will learn about the way that light is reflected, and how shadows form and are effected by the position of the light.

Geography

Children will learn about mountains and mountainous regions in geography. We will examine what mountains are, how they are formed and in which parts of the world they are. Children will also look at how they affect the people who live in them.

English

Our writing will link to our theme of ourselves and our aspirations, starting off with story writing and instructions. Handwriting and spelling will be a focus for the start of the term, and throughout the term we will work on extending vocabulary, both in reading and writing. We will be reading every morning using Destination Reader, and our class book is *Wonder*.

Maths

Children will extend their knowledge of place value to include larger numbers. We will focus on securing written methods, and be learning to multiply using columnar method and divide using a formal written method. We will also extend our understanding of fractions and decimals and start to perform more calculations with these.



ICT

Children will use ICT to produce pieces of work, building on their use of texts and graphics. We will also have a strong focus on online safety, and will be learning about how to use the internet and other communication platforms safely.

R.E.

We are studying Christianity, focussing on religion, family and worship and looking at the role and importance of sacred places

French

Children will be working with a teacher from Stowupland High School this year in French, building up their vocabulary as well as constructing more complex sentences.

Music

Children will develop an understanding of the history of music through listening to a variety of pieces and responding creatively.
