

Music

This term, all the learning is focused around the song Let Your Spirit Fly. We will also be learning how to make the best use of our vocal skills, in readiness for the Christmas production.

P.E.

This term, we will be swimming on Tuesdays. In PE, we will be learning tactics to help improve our invasion game skills in tag rugby.

Art

We will be creating Roman-inspired face pots using clay, linking with our history unit. We will look at the context of these creations as well as how to develop our skills in creating coil pots and embellishments with clay.

D&T

We will be using our design and joinery skills to create picture frames.

Science

Animals, including humans: We will be building upon our learning from the summer term (Wellbeing Week) around the importance of a healthy diet and the impact upon the body. We will be exploring some of the different processes and the structures within the body and designing our own experiments to test our ideas on the topic.



History

This term, we will be learning all about the Romans. We will be looking at why they came here, what they did while they were here and what was their impact, as well as how they lived, their beliefs and culture.

English

Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening. We will focus on different text types this term, including poetry, adventure and mysteries stories, formal letters and scripts. Throughout these, children will build on their sentence structures and vocabulary, a range of punctuation and work towards gaining their pen licences.

Maths

We will be taking a mastery approach to Maths, which means that the children will be able to explore the Maths concepts to a deeper level through problem solving. This term, we will be focusing up the four major operations (addition, subtraction, division and multiplication). We will also be looking at perimeter and area.

ICT

We will be looking at E-Safety and some of the strategies to help stay safe on-line. We will also be looking at how to use the internet for research and how check the reliability of a source.

R.E.

We will be exploring some key Buddhism teaching. As well as exploring some of the key aspects of the Christian faith, such as important festivals and symbols.

French

Children will be building up their vocabulary, constructing simple sentences as well as consolidating their learning from last year.

Geography

We will be exploring why some earthquakes cause more damage than others. We will look at what an earthquake is, as well as working on our map skills.
