

Geography

United Kingdom Study: We will name, locate and identify the 4 countries of the U.K and discuss our experiences of visiting them. We will also make observations of seasonal weather patterns in the U.K.

Science

Animals, including humans: We will name and compare the structure of animals and classify them as carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. We will use our observations to answer questions and research in order to produce information leaflets.

English

We will explore stories to do with animals and zoos and use this as the basis for our own story writing. We will then research mammals using non-fiction texts and the internet, using what we learn to write information leaflets. We will link our learning with History to read short biographies of important figures and write recalled facts ourselves.

Computing

Creating and retrieving data- We will use digital art apps to draw, colour and design an art piece linked to animals in science. We will learn to use different tools to produce effects, edit and erase, as well as save and retrieve our work.

P.E.

Games: We will explore throwing and catching techniques, whilst improving our agility.

Gymnastics: We will create, perform and share sequences. We will work on body tension and movements which use different levels.

Art and DT

DT- Making vehicles with wheels and axels: We will design and make our own vehicles, exploring joining and movement.

Art- Weaving Easter Baskets: We will explore colour, texture and shape, as well as weaving techniques and effects.

History

Castles- We will explore how and why castles were built and the people of the past who built them. We will compare life in a castle to modern day and discuss changes over time.

Maths

We will explore number patterns and relationships such as doubles. We will investigate and build up mental methods of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also explore fractions of objects and shapes, position and movement, telling the time and collecting data using tallies and charts.
